Conditions Governing Reproduction of Works of Art in the Leonard & Bina Ellen Art Gallery Permanent Collection

- 1. Permission is granted only for one in one publication, one edition, and in one language. Usage in additional language editions and subsequent revised editions must be the subject of another written request. Photographic material may not be reused without the written permission of the Leonard & Bina Ellen Art Gallery.
- 2. Reproduction must be made from photographic documents provided by the Leonard & Bina Ellen Art Gallery.
- 3. The artist and work of art must be properly identified. In addition, the credit line as specified must appear on the same page as the reproduction, or on the opposite page, or on the reverse. The credit line must read exactly as provided by the Leonard & Bina Ellen Art Gallery:

Kindly note that any abbreviation of the credit line must be approved by the Leonard & Bina Ellen Art Gallery in advance of publication.

- 4. The works of art are to be reproduced in their entirety without cropping, and without any alteration by overprint or superimposed imagery. Any reproduction of a detail or portion of a work of art must be the subject of another written request indicating the section to be reproduced. If permission is granted, the word "detail" must be included in the title caption. The reproduction may not be reproduced on coloured stock.
- 5. The applicant is responsible for obtaining copyright of all works of art protected by the Copyright Law. The Leonard & Bina Ellen Art Gallery is absolved of all responsibility should the necessary copyright clearance not be obtained by the applicant.
- 6. Two copies of the publication must be sent to the Leonard & Bina Ellen Art Gallery for documentation purposes.
