The Leonard & Bina Ellen Art Gallery is currently accepting project proposals from students in the MFA Studio Arts and the PhD Humanities programs for its annual exhibition IGNITION. This manifestation provides the opportunity for students to present their recent research in the context of a professional gallery with a national and international profile. They will work in collaboration with the gallery's team to develop an exhibition that critically explores questions related to each one's artistic practice.

The exhibition will feature between 5 to 9 projects, selected by a guest curator or critic and the Ellen Art Gallery's Director. The proposed or submitted work must be a new project (produced within the last 12 months), and not have been exhibited previously in Montreal. Proposals for non-gallery-based projects or performance works are welcome. Past IGNITION participants are not eligible.

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSIONS: FEBRUARY 28th AT 5 PM (by email)

Selected artists will be notified by the week of MARCH 17th

Submissions must include the following information:

1. Artist Statement + Project Proposal (max. 1 page)

- Full name, address, phone number, email, and level of graduate studies
- Artist statement relating to proposed project
- Project proposal: a clear concise description (form and concept).
- Technical requirements: (Please note: the Gallery has limited audio-visual resources. Students must be prepared to provide their own A/V equipment if needed).

2. A current CV (max. 2 pages)

3. Documentation

- Still Images: 15 jpg images (max.) of previous and if possible of proposed work. A numbered list indicating artist, title, medium, dimensions, and production date
- Video / audio works: provide a link to one or two video / audio works from a personal website, or from a site such as YouTube or Vimeo. A description indicating artist, title, medium, duration and production date.
