Prakash is an artist-researcher and cultural worker whose focus is on accessibility, contemporary art, and education. He has published widely on art, feminist archives, South Asian visual culture, and 2SLGBTQ+ organizing in the form of reviews, interviews, zines, essays, and journal articles. Prakash's previous roles include research associate and coordinator at Access in the Making Lab, educator at the PHI Foundation for Contemporary Art, and manager of cultural mediation at Centre CLARK. He holds a MA in Media Studies from Concordia University.
